Dear Hauled Waste Manager:

**Subject: Waste Haulers License Permit Renewal (2011) for the
Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati (MSD), Ohio.**

This is a reminder regarding the renewal of your Waste Haulers holding tank discharge permit for 2011. The annual permit fee is **\$140.00** for each truck and shall cover one year beginning January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011 in accordance with the Metropolitan Sewer District Rules and Regulations, effective March 1, 2001. The fee for both the sanitary and commercial dumping tickets for 2011 is **\$50.00** per 1,000 gallons.

The permit will be issued for sanitary sewage originating in the MSD service area only. Permits to haul sewage originating outside the MSD service area, and/or non-sanitary waste, including treatment, commercial, or industrial wastes (for example: grease traps, car wash pits, utility chambers, etc.), will be issued separately.

The Holding Tank Discharge Permits (truck stickers) are issued in person at the MSD Septage Receiving Station, 1600 Gest Street, Cincinnati, Ohio 45204, between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except on holidays. Truck drivers must call the Division of Industrial Waste at 513-557-7000 to schedule an appointment to receive the permit stickers.

Dumping tickets can be purchased at the MSD Tap Permits and Records office, located in the Waste Water Engineering Building at 1035 Woodrow Street, Cincinnati, Ohio 45204. This fee will be deposited into a trust account and must be done in advance of discharge. Payment for dumping tickets can be made by check or cash only.

Enclosed is a copy of the following for processing:

- Revised application form for the permit to discharge.
- Waste Haulers bond form. Also, note that the bond form is on the MSD website at www.msdcg.org and it is interactive for your convenience.
- A copy of the MSD Rules and Regulations, Article XIV, regarding the disposal of the holding tank waste.

Please remit the following directly to MSD, 1600 Gest Street, Division of Industrial Waste, Cincinnati, Ohio 45204, attention: Ms. Chanda Coleman:

1. The enclosed application form for permit to discharge.
2. A check, payable to the Treasurer, City of Cincinnati, for **\$140.00** for **each truck**.
3. Executed, original bond form with a current power of attorney. If MSD currently has a bond, an original copy of a continuation certificate is acceptable in place of a new bond.

Please note: The name of the business listed on the discharge permit and the bond for each truck shall be the same as the name of the business that is listed with the Ohio Secretary of State. Any discrepancy in information will cause a delay in processing your discharge permit and bond. Once your discharge permit is approved MSD will process your hauler's bond.

Discharging of any substance directly into a manhole or other opening in the wastewater treatment system is prohibited per MSD Rules & Regulations Article XV, Section 1516. Violations of this rule will result in fines and penalties and will be subject to progressive enforcement action.
