Regarding: Metropolitan Sewer District (MSD) of Greater Cincinnati for the Waste Hauler Tank Vehicle Permit Renewal (2022)

Dear Facility Manager:

The 2022 Annual Permit Fee and Disposal Fee - **pending final approval by the Hamilton County Board of County Commissioners** – will become effective January 1, 2022.

The annual permit fee of \$170.00 for each truck will be assessed for completed permit & bond submittals received by MSD no later than December 31, 2021. The annual permit fee covers one year beginning January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022 in accordance with the MSD Rules and Regulations, effective March 1, 2001. The proposed annual permit fee of \$190.00 will become effective beginning January 1, 2022, if approved by the Board. The permit will be issued for sanitary sewage originating in the MSD service area only. Permits to haul sewage originating outside the MSD service area, and/or non-sanitary waste, including treatment, commercial, or industrial wastes (for example: grease traps, car wash pits, utility chambers, etc.), must be approved by the Director and may be issued separately.

Cash or credit card payments for hauled waste disposal fees must be paid in person at MSD Development Services, located at 1035 Woodrow Street, Cincinnati, Ohio 45204. Check payments may be mailed or paid in person. This fee will be deposited into a trust account and must be paid in advance of discharge.

The fee for both sanitary and commercial hauled waste disposal is \$6.00 per 100 gallons, and will remain in effect through December 31, 2021. The proposed disposed fee of \$7.00 per 100 gallons will become effective January 1, 2022, if approved by the Board.

Enclosed is a copy of the following for processing:

- Waste Haulers bond form. The bond form is also located on the MSD website at: msdgc.org under Customer Care / Waste Haulers and is interactive for your convenience.
- A copy of the MSD Rules and Regulations, Article XIV, regarding the disposal of holding tank waste.

The following must be submitted by December 1*5*, 2021 to MSD - Compliance Services Division, attention: David Pyles, 1600 Gest Street, Cincinnati, Ohio 45204:

- 1. Executed, original bond form with a current power of attorney form. The notary who signed the bond must be listed on the power of attorney form. If MSD currently has a bond, an original copy of a continuation certificate is acceptable in place of a new bond.
- 2. A check, payable to Treasurer, City of Cincinnati, for the **annual permit fee for each tank vehicle**.

Please note: The name of the business listed on the bond for each truck shall be the same as the name of the business that is listed with the Ohio Secretary of State. Any discrepancy in information or late submittal will cause a delay in processing your discharge permit and bond.

Holding tank vehicle capacity must be accurately stated on the bond application and is subject to verification by MSD.

Discharging of any substance directly into a manhole or other opening in the wastewater treatment system is prohibited per MSD Rules & Regulations Article XV, Section 1502.1.B.18. Violations of this rule will result in fines and penalties and will be subject to enforcement action.
